### 148/25 Open Forum

Mr Peter Verso from Immersa a locally based company was welcomed to the meeting by Councillor Pearcy, Mr Verso attended the meeting to highlight the opportunity of the Community funded solar scheme.

The aim of the fund is to help kickstart projects including small-scale solar partnerships, all proposed, designed and owned by local people, the community fund needs the local community to raise 20% and then 80% is funded, the council would be paid for the energy that goes into the grid although local usage would take priority.

The council owns a piece of land which may be suitable for the project, which is 0.6 acres and could potentially create about 200kw possibly higher, solar charges the battery and then the battery feeds into the grid. The site would be low maintenance, you need to clean the panels once a year.

To progress, an outline design would be drawn up and a satellite image of the field produced, then funding can be explored.

The panels have a life span of approximately 25 years, then there is usually a 15 -20 % decline in performance, a community scheme can be hard to manage for a small parish council.

There is a lot for the council to consider.
